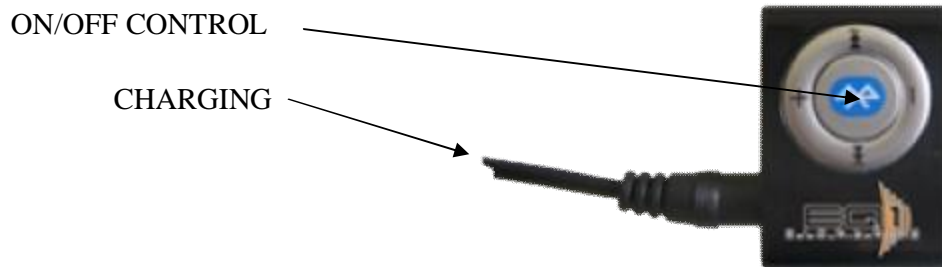


Your EQ Blue Tooth system has been specially designed to interface with the EQ1 Wireless Headset System. It will not function correctly when connected to any other system.



Charging.

To charge your EQ blue tooth plug in the supplied USB charging adaptor to the unit and plug the USB end into any USB outlet. The RED charging light will come on and will go out when the battery is fully charged (10 hours max).

ON/OFF controls.

Press and hold the centre ON Blue Tooth button until the blue light comes on, if the RED light is on then the unit needs charging. The unit will auto power off if its not connected to any Blue Tooth devices. Press and hold to turn off. Ensure EQ Blue Tooth is connected to the EQ1 Base Controller via the 3.5mm stereo plug and is as far from the Base as possible.

Pairing.

The Blue Tooth device needs to be paired with your mobile in order to operate. Put the EQ Blue Tooth in pairing mode by holding the ON button for 5 seconds, the RED and Blue lights will then alternate. Use your mobile to search for Blue Tooth devices until the BS-825i is found, then select it. The pass code is “0000” for this device.

Operation.

Calls from you mobile may be answered by pressing the ON button when unit is in operation. Make calls in the normal way from your mobile and use the headsets to talk on as required. If VHF radio traffic is received then the cell phone audio will be muted for the duration of the traffic.

Your Blue Tooth system will provide approximately 5 hours of talk time and 100 hours of standby operation.
